- Ans) There is an option of Minor in Social Sciences (CSEP) which covers comprehensive subjects aligned with UPSC General Studies and CSAT. It includes training in ethics, governance, and current affairs, combined with workshops and mock tests conducted by experts.

- Ans) Students participate in:
 - i. Samvaad: Debates and discussions on political and constitutional issues.
 - ii. VideshNeeti: Publishing research on international relations.
 - iii. Guest lectures by diplomats and policymakers.
 - iv. Also, multiple student clubs and societies
 - v. Freedom to start their own society or any multidisciplinary initiative

- Ans) Courses like Kautilya's Arthashastra, and Ancient Indian Research Tools, Indic perspectives and political thoughts provide insights into governance, statecraft, and research methodologies rooted in Indian traditions, bridging them with contemporary political science.
