Chanakya University

Chanakya University is a new-age, interdisciplinary university located in Bengaluru, Karnataka, near Kempegowda International Airport, within the Aerospace Industrial Zone. Situated in a corridor shaped by global enterprise, the University draws energy from its surroundings while shaping a distinct academic culture of inquiry and purpose.

The University is founded on the conviction that contemporary challenges demand integrative thinking and contextual understanding. Learning encourages students to engage with complexity by examining how economic, technological, social, and legal forces interact. This philosophy is realised through the University's academic structure. 






MoU Immersion Programme with IIM Nagpur




