I, R. Sundaram, a Registered Architect bearing Registration No. CA /75/1404, hereby certify that the existing buildings of Chanakya University, located at Haralur, Devanahalli, Bangalore, have been designed and planned in compliance with the AICTE Approval Process Handbook and applicable guidelines for creating a barrier-free environment.

The following provisions have been incorporated in and around the campus to ensure accessibility for persons with disabilities, elderly individuals, and all users:

1. Accessible Entrances & Pathways

- At least one main entrance in each building is designed to be barrier-free and accessible.
- Ramps are provided alongside staircases with appropriate gradients, in accordance with the National Building Code.
- Clear signage indicating accessible routes has been provided.

2. Vertical Accessibility

- Buildings are designed with ramps for movement between levels.
- Lifts are provided to ensure access to all floors.

3. Sanitary Facilities

- Accessible toilets are provided on each floor.
- Toilets are designed to accommodate wheelchair users and comply with accessibility norms.



4. Parking & Circulation

- Reserved parking spaces for persons with disabilities are provided near entrances.
- Pathways are designed to allow smooth wheelchair movement across the campus.

5. Safety & Usability Features

- Handrails, non-slip flooring, and adequate lighting provisions are incorporated.
- User-friendly design elements are provided wherever required.

6. Inclusive Campus Planning

- Academic, administrative, and common facilities are designed to be accessible.
- The campus ensures a safe, inclusive, and barrier-free learning environment for all stakeholders.

This certification is issued based on the architectural drawings, site planning, and design provisions, and is in conformity with KIADB, AICTE norms, the National Building Code, and Government of India guidelines for a barrier-free built environment.

We hereby affirm that the institution complies with the accessibility requirements prescribed by the competent authorities.
